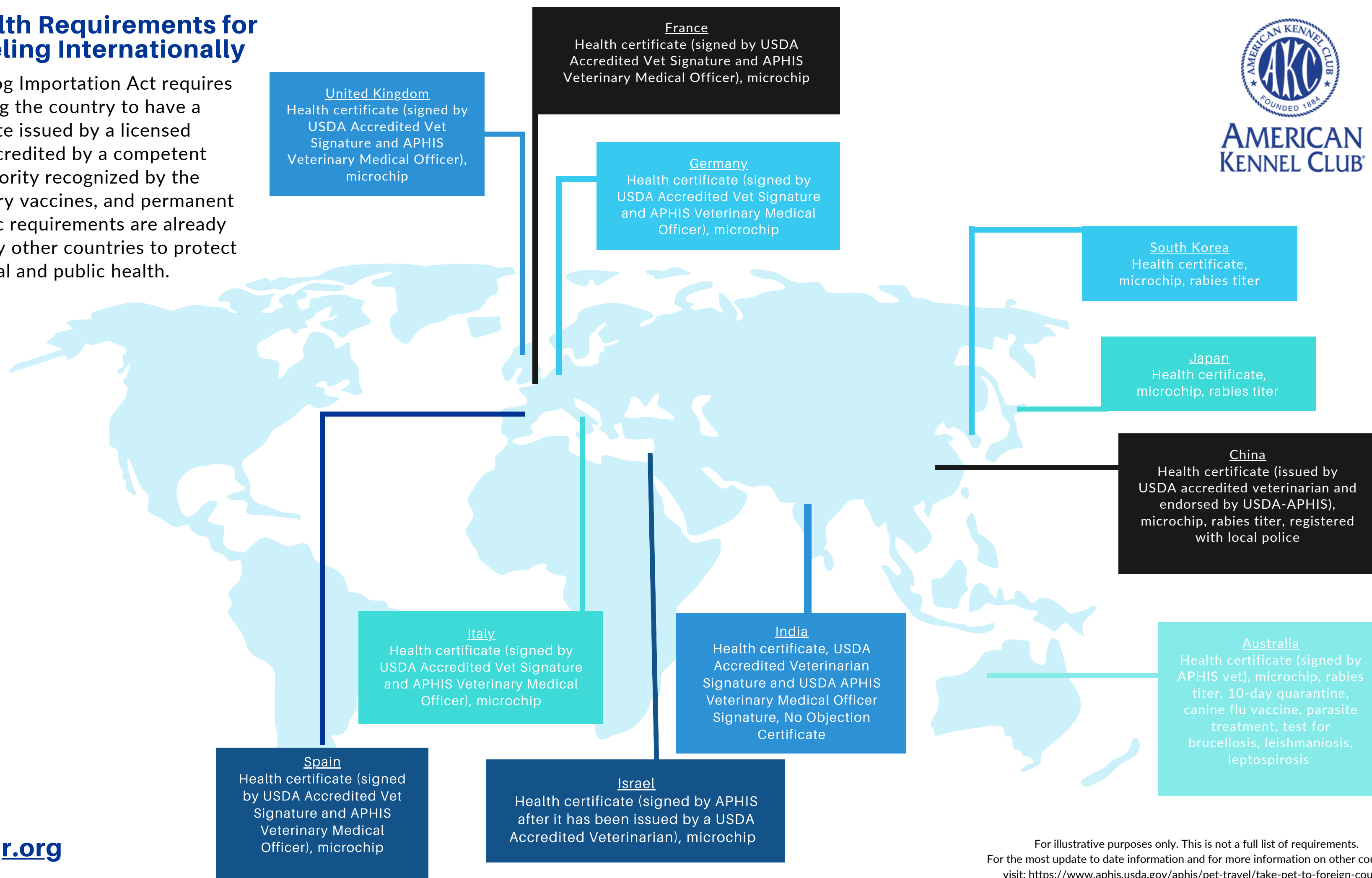

Sample Health Requirements for Dogs Traveling Internationally

The Healthy Dog Importation Act requires all dogs entering the country to have a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian accredited by a competent veterinary authority recognized by the USDA, necessary vaccines, and permanent ID. Similar basic requirements are already in place in many other countries to protect their own animal and public health.



United Kingdom
Health certificate (signed by USDA Accredited Vet Signature and APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer), microchip

France
Health certificate (signed by USDA Accredited Vet Signature and APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer), microchip

Germany
Health certificate (signed by USDA Accredited Vet Signature and APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer), microchip

South Korea
Health certificate, microchip, rabies titer

Japan
Health certificate, microchip, rabies titer

China
Health certificate (issued by USDA accredited veterinarian and endorsed by USDA-APHIS), microchip, rabies titer, registered with local police

Italy
Health certificate (signed by USDA Accredited Vet Signature and APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer), microchip

India
Health certificate, USDA Accredited Veterinarian Signature and USDA APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer Signature, No Objection Certificate

Australia
Health certificate (signed by APHIS vet), microchip, rabies titer, 10-day quarantine, canine flu vaccine, parasite treatment, test for brucellosis, leishmaniosis, leptospirosis

Spain
Health certificate (signed by USDA Accredited Vet Signature and APHIS Veterinary Medical Officer), microchip

Israel
Health certificate (signed by APHIS after it has been issued by a USDA Accredited Veterinarian), microchip
