On behalf of the Association of the United States Navy, we would like to pledge our support for H.R. 1749, the Veterans Early Treatment for Chronic Ailment Resurgence through Examinations (VET CARE) Act.

This bill would require the Veterans Administration (VA) to put in place a four-year pilot program providing dental care for Veterans. Right now, dental care through the VA is limited to those who are 100% disabled or have a direct service connected injury.

Studies have shown that regular dental care helps alleviate certain chronic conditions, reducing overall health care costs. Since the VA spends most of its health care costs on treating Veterans with chronic ailments, like diabetes, heart conditions, and more, dental coverage would help ensure a healthier Veteran population and bring those costs down.
